

DORIS DUKE CHARITABLE FOUNDATION CLINICAL SCIENTIST DEVELOPMENT AWARD FOR 2010

The Doris Duke Clinical Scientist Development Award Program supports junior faculty early in their careers as independent clinical researchers in any disease area.

AWARD PROGRAM

This program is designed to assist physician-scientists in transitioning from trainees to independent clinical investigators. Applicants with an M.D. or M.D./Ph.D. must have been appointed to their first full-time faculty level position between January 1, 2005 and January 1, 2010. The Foundation strongly encourages women and under-represented minorities in medicine to apply for the program. This award provides \$135,000 per year (including \$10,000 for facilities and administrative costs) for three (3) years.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNAL PEER REVIEW AT JOHNS HOPKINS

Johns Hopkins can submit two (2) nominations for this program. The internal peer review to select nominees will be conducted by the Office of the Assistant Provost for Research Administration.

Interested candidates should submit a complete packet of materials for internal review no later than 6 p.m. on **Monday, November 2, 2009**, via email, to malexander@jhu.edu. Each applicant will receive a confirmation of receipt of their materials within 48 hours. If you do not receive such an acknowledgement, please contact Michael J. Alexander directly at: (410) 516-8734 or by e-mail. Selected nominees must submit their materials to the DDCF no later than Tuesday, **December 22, 2009**.

Applicants should submit these documents as one PDF in the following sequence:

1. JHU Internal Submission Cover Sheet
2. Curriculum Vitae (two to four pages, listing all funding sources)
3. Proposed research plan (4-5 pages, not including figures and references)
4. Letter of recommendation from the candidate's department chair/director
